(Numbers refer to sections above)

(3) If either of you will not be 18 on the date of the wedding, the priest will need to know whether the consent of parents or guardians has been obtained

(4, 11, 12) It is possible to marry in Church if you have been divorced, and anyone in this position should consult their parish priest

(6) Please ensure you include the name of the Town, County and Postcode

(7) (i) A stepfather's name can be given if he is married to the mother but "stepfather" must be included in brackets
(ii) If father is deceased, add "Deceased" after father's name

(8) Please state father's occupation and add "retired" if appropriate after the occupation. This information is required even if father is deceased. Please write occupation in full (e.g. Information Technology Manager, rather than I.T. Manager).

(15) This means the Church of England Parish in which you live. If either of you lives in a different Parish from that in which the marriage is to take place, you have to arrange for the banns to be read there too and obtain a banns certificate
