### **Communion**

- Communion should be administered in one kind only (bread) with no sharing of the common cup
- The priest should sanitise their hands before administering the consecrated bread
- Each communicant should also be encouraged to sanitise their hands before receiving the bread
- The consecrated bread or wafer will need to be dropped into the hands of communicants
- Communicants should not come to kneel at the altar rail, but instead they should form a line maintaining two metres' distance to receive the bread standing (not kneeling), from the priest.

## Cleaning

- Pews to be cleaned after each indoor service
- Door handles and any other touch points to be cleaned after each service
- Chairs used for outdoor services to be cleaned after each service
