We are always on the lookout for new singers; we have choristers ranging from 8 years old to considerably over 80. Although we try to sing ambitious repertoire to a high standard, all of us were beginners once and you will find a warm welcome whatever your prior experience and abilities.

We rehearse on Friday evenings and usually sing either a Sunday morning or evening service each week – sometimes both. We do recognise that people have busy lives and encourage choristers to attend whenever they can without feeling guilty when they cannot!

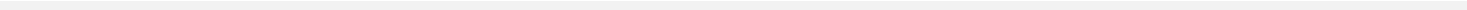
